The Gloucester Township Police Department is now recruiting individuals interested in becoming police officers. The New Jersey Civil Service Commission has announced the 2026 Law Enforcement Examination (LEE), which is the first step in the hiring process. Applicants must meet several requirements, including being a U.S. citizen, possessing a high school diploma or equivalent, and being between the ages of 18 and 35 at the time of application. Those selected must successfully complete a police training program and meet additional standards, including medical and professional appearance requirements.
