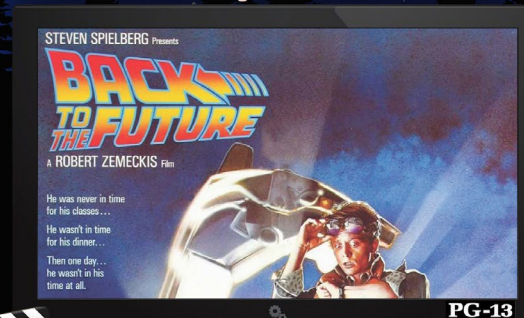

Pet Safety During The Summer

GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP POLICE HEAT PET SAFETY TIPS!



SHADE & WATER

Protect your pets from the sun's rays and keep them hydrated.



NO CARS

Never leave a pet in the car, not even with the window cracked.



HEAT STROKE

Excessive panting, discolored gums, and mobility problems are signs. Seek veterinary attention immediately!



NO ASPHALT

If it's too hot for bare feet, it's too hot for bare paws.



LIMIT EXERCISE

Don't let playful pets over exert themselves in the heat.

Summertime is here, and with temperatures rising into

the 90s over the next week, the Gloucester Township Police Department reminds residents to protect their pets during the summer heat. Keep indoor temperatures cool with air conditioning or fans, limit outdoor time to early mornings or evenings, and always have fresh water available.

Never leave your pet in a parked car, even for a few minutes. If it is too hot for you to walk barefoot, it is too hot for your pets, so provide them with "paw-wear" or keep them off hot surfaces. Pet owners should also watch for signs of heatstroke, including heavy panting, weakness, or vomiting.
