Gloucester Township proudly celebrated the opening of the new Fitness Court® at Veterans Park with a ribbon-cutting ceremony!

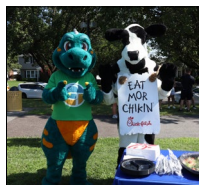

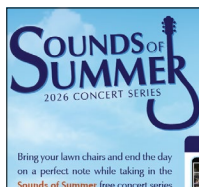
