**Text/ Phone Call From "Bank Fraud Department"
Convincing Victims To
Send Money via Ride Shares**

The Gloucester Township Police Department are warning residents about a scam targeting older adults. Scammers posing as bank representatives are asking victims to secretly withdraw cash or send money through a courier or cryptocurrency.

Banks, police departments, and government agencies will never ask you to do this. Hang up, contact your bank directly, and please share this warning with elderly family members, friends, and neighbors.
