ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 81 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER ENTITLED, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Gloucester, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that Chapter 81 of the Code of the Township of Gloucester be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 81-35C "Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on All Other Private Property" be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Property:

VALLEYBROOK

Little Gloucester Road (C.R. 759)

Regulations:

1. General Parking:

A. All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.

B. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets described here below:

Doral Dr.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection or part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication as required by law.

Ms. Pine stated that PW went into the middle and did nothing on the edge of the property.

Pete Heinbaugh of Morningstar Court thanked the Clerk's Office for being timely with the minutes.

Joanne Carr of Timberbirch questioned the open space money and spoke about the certified rateables. Mr. Cardis stated that they are the assessed value of the towns rateables. She asked how the township pays its bills when we do not collect the tax money. Mr. Cardis explained the accelerated tax sale. Ms. Carr thanked the Council for a great Gloucester Township Day.

Patricia Klein asked why the township voted on renewing the Liquor license for Villari's due to the problems they are having with the playing of loud music. She also asked about Mr. Brown's development and the paving that was done previously at the development. Mr. Cantwell explained that sealant was put on the streets in this development. He stated that the development was not severe enough to do a full paving. She stated that this is wasted taxpayer money.

Maureen Redrow of 125 Empire Road asked a question for Ms Sarah Bass Young. She asked for a street light at Peter Cheeseman Road between Hickstown Road and Garwood Road as it is extremely dark. She asked if there is an ordinance for commercial vehicles being parked in a residential area as she is having problems with a parked truck in her neighborhood. She also questioned the open space and recreation funds – and stated that the township has so many tennis courts throughout the town that are in disrepair. Mr. Mercado stated that two are being resurfaced at Broadmoor West and Broadmoor off Bee Lane. She asked if there was any consideration for a pool at the southern end of town. Mr. Cardis stated that the pool the township has was donated to the township. Mr. Williams of Erial spoke about Gloucester Township Day and asked who is in charge of hiring vendors for Gloucester Township Day. He questioned the price of the rides and asked that this vendor list be reviewed. He stated that he feels that the prices at Gloucester Township Day are too high. Mr. Mercado stated that there are 3 signature events in the township. The Pumpkin Festival, GT Day, and the Blackwood Parade. He stated that GT Day is run by the GT Scholarship Committee and they put that event together. The Pumpkin Festival is run by Mainstage and the Blackwood Christmas Parade is run by the Blackwood Fire Company. He stated that the township supports these events but they do not run the events. Mr. Mercado will forward his comments to the committee.

Mr. Brown of Erial spoke about the roads in his neighborhood and stated that they were told the roads would be paved. He stated they were done and the job was not done properly. He stated that maybe the inspectors need more training. Mr. Brown also spoke about cost of living raises and asked if the employee's raises could be capped at 1.5 percent. Mr. Cardis stated that all contracts are currently being negotiated. He also asked about the past tax increases and the election. Mr. Brown questioned why there wasn't a special night at the Council meetings for the Veteran's. Mr. Mercado stated that the township has 8 monuments and a Memorial Day service out at Veteran's Park. Mr. Brown stated that he would like to see the township have a Veteran's Day Parade.

There being no further comment, the public portion was closed.

Mr. Mercado thanked the residents for coming to the meeting. He reminded everyone that there will be a movie in the park this Friday "Sing". He stated that the Field of Dreams will be having their last game on the 17th. He also stated that the relay of Life held in Veterans Park is in thir 8th year. He congratulated those people who won in the recent primary election and those who engaged in the process.
