**PUBLIC PORTION:**

Mr. Mercado opened the public portion.

There being no comment, the public portion was closed.

1. **DISCUSSION OF PROPOSAL TO DEVELOP A PUNCHLIST FOR LAKESIDE BUSINESS PARK – WILLIAMSTOWN ROAD** – Tony Chadwell of Remington & Vernick was present at the meeting. The bond for this project is in the process of being pulled. It was asked whether the township could be reimbursed from the bond proceeds. It was stated that the project would have to be done first to see if there is any money left. A straw poll was taken and all members were in agreement for R & V to develop a punchlist...
  
2. **DISCUSSION OF DESIGN/INSPECTION SERVICES FOR EXTENDING REPAVING OF HAMPTON LANE** – This project was discussed and a straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement allowing R & V to include the design/inspection services for extending the repaving of Hampton Lane.
  
3. **DISCUSSION OF AMENDING CHAPTER 67A-24,25 IN THE EVENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY**- Mr. Carlamere spoke about the fact that our ordinance specifies that all violation notices must be sent out by certified mail. It was stated that cases throughout the township that go to Superior Court are being dismissed when there is no evidence of them being sent a certified letter. It was stated that the township has an obligation to do its due process. The ordinance will be revised to state all notifications will be posted on the door, mailed and sent by certified mail.  
Mr. Lechner discussed a revision to the ordinance for vehicle parking. It was stated that some people are parking their cars on their lawns or adjacent to their driveways. Mr. Lechner stated that with the amendments these problems should be alleviated. He will prepare the ordinance for a future meeting.
