Box 8, Blackwood, New Jersey 08012 (hereinafter called "GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP"), and Township of Winslow, located at 125 South Route 73, Braddock, New Jersey 08037-9422 (hereinafter called "TOWNSHIP OF WINSLOW").

WITNESSETH

**WHEREAS.** The parties desire to enter into a Municipal Services Agreement authorizing Gloucester Township to provide "Brine Solution to the Township of Winslow, and

**WHEREAS.** The parties desire to enter into an agreement memorializing the terms and conditions of the agreement between GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP and TOWNSHIP OF WINSLOW.

**NOW THEREFORE,** for and inconsideration of the signing of this Agreement by the parties, and in further consideration of the terms and covenants of the within Agreement, and the mutual benefits derived by the parties hereto, the Parties do hereby agree as follows:
